

# FRANCE IN THE MIDDLE EAST



Although largely eluded in David Lean's film, France nonetheless encouraged and participated in the Great Arab Revolt and, to a lesser extent, in the Sinai and Palestine campaigns. In 1916, Lieutenant-Colonel (and future General) Édouard Brémont was appointed head of the French military mission in Egypt and the Hijaz, with a twofold objective: to give France a foothold in the region and thus keep an eye on the coveted territories in Syria, and to help reopen the road to Mecca to Muslim pilgrims from its colonies.






Made up of Muslim officers and non-commissioned officers from the tirailleurs and spahis regiments, Lieutenant-Colonel Brémont's military mission played an active role in training the Sharif army, and also supplied rifles and two artillery batteries. In the same time, France also sent an intervention force to Suez. In April 1917, the French Palestine and Syria Detachment landed at Port Said. This small force was placed under British command, integrated into the allied army and fought during the Sinai and Palestine campaign.

The city of Damascus fell to the British and the forces of the Great Arab Revolt on 3 October 1918. French troops landed in Beirut 5 days later. In 1920, France received a mandate over Syria and Lebanon from the League of Nations. To maintain order in these territories, France set up the **Army of the Levant**, made up mainly of troops from the African Army and colonial troops.











The **Army of the Levant** fought against Kemal Atatürk's Turks during the Cilicia campaign between 1918 and 1921, against the troops of Faisal I during the Franco-Syrian war in 1920, against Sultan el-Atrache's Druze during the Druze Revolt between 1925 and 1927 and finally against the Allies during the Syrian campaign in 1941. The Army of the Levant was disbanded at the end of the Second World War when Lebanon and Syria became independent.

## SPECIAL TROOPS OF THE LEVANT

In 1922, the troops recruited locally from the various Christian and Muslim communities were given the name of **Special troops of the Levant**, divided into "auxiliary units" organised like French troops, and "auxiliaries suppletives units" made up of partisans who received a high salary.

# THEATRE OF OPERATIONS


## MIDDLE EAST 1916-1927

### RECRUITMENT: TRANSPORTING AMMUNITION

A group with the skill  can be upgraded to ammunition transport free of charge.

A group located in the same zone as a group carrying ammunition shoots with an extra die.  
If the ammunition transport is destroyed by fire, any group located in the same area is also destroyed.

### NEW SKILL



	<b>MOUNTAINEER</b>	Once per activation, a group with the Mountaineer skill considers very difficult terrain (excluding buildings) to be difficult terrain.

### CAPTAIN PISANI

Mentioned several times in T.E. Lawrence's "*The Seven Pillars of Wisdom*", Captain Rosario Pisani took part in all the battles of the Great Arab Revolt at the head of a hundred men from North Africa, equipped with machine guns and 65 mm mountain guns.

- ◆ *Captain Pisani is a hero who can only be recruited by the French army and the Great Arab Revolt.*
- ◆ *When recruited by an army in the Great Arab Revolt, Captain Pisani can activate allied collective weapons only and can be considered as a leader by them only.*

<b>Train of mules:</b> Captain Pisani treats the first passable terrain area he crosses as a road. He cannot charge and fight with a single die in close combat.						
<b>Technician:</b> when Captain Pisani activates a collective weapon, his experience changes from "Regular" to "Veteran" in order to adjust his shot when ranging in and/or shooting.						







## ARMENIAN LEGION

Created in 1916 to fight the Ottomans and form the nucleus of the future Armenian army, the **Oriental Legion** brought together more than 4,000 volunteers, mainly Armenians but also Syrians and Lebanese, trained in Cyprus and led by French officers. As part of the Syria and Palestine Detachment, the **Oriental Legion** distinguished itself during the Battle of Arara in 1918. Renamed the **Armenian Legion** in 1919, it then fought in the Cilicia campaign before finally being disbanded in 1920 when France decided to abandon the region.

When granted a mandate by the League of Nations in 1920, France decided to rely on the specific characteristics of the various communities present in Syria and Lebanon: Maronites, Greeks, Armenians, Assyro-Chaldeans, nomadic Bedouins, Kurds, Alawites, Ismailis, Turks, Circassians, Druze...

## 1er RÉGIMENT ÉTRANGER DE CAVALERIE

Based on the experience of legionnaires who had served in White light cavalry units during the Russian Civil War, the 1st regiment étranger de cavalerie was created in 1921 and involved from 1925 in Morocco and during the Druze revolt. It distinguished itself in particular during the battles of Messifre and Rachaya.
